We are looking for committed individuals to expand the range of Trustee skills as well as to consolidate existing skills with an eye to succession planning. We require dynamic and motivated people who are sympathetic to the aims and objectives of VOYC Devon to fulfil these voluntary duties. We expect Trustees to contribute actively to the Board by giving strategic direction; setting overall policy; defining goals and setting targets; evaluating performance; ensuring the charity's effective and efficient administration and financial stability.

We want to have a wide range of people on the Board, and seek to be representative of the diverse population we have in Devon. There is no need to have trustee experience to apply. An interest in supporting children and younger people is necessary. In addition, on the basis of a recent skills audit, we are looking for someone with experience in the Health Sector, to deepen our expertise in that area.

Trustees are expected to:-

- attend up to seven meetings a year including bi-monthly Board meetings (all currently on Friday mornings) and an Annual General Meeting;
- get involved in fixed term task groups;
- contribute advice and support on an ad hoc basis.
